**Note 2:** Students are also required to participate in 6 sessions of non-graded individual therapy, at their expense, with a department-approved outside counsellor of their choice.

**Note 3:** BI5102 must be taken prior to, or concurrently with, the first OT or NT Bible course. (Available to Distance students less frequently, it must be taken prior to, or concurrent with, the second OT or NT Bible course.) This does not apply to MA (Theological Studies) students.

**Note 4:** BI7107, OT5320, and NT5320 are offered simultaneously as a combined course, and students may select which version to take, each with different syllabi and assignments.

**Note 5:** The total cost for CP5501 is \$2,400, which includes tuition and all additional fees (not including the individual therapy in Note 2 or room and board). For international students, this amount will increase by the regular difference between international and domestic tuition.

**Note 6:** Practicum 3 & 4 students will be required to secure their own internship placement and clinical supervision. Depending on the internship arrangement, students may be required to pay directly for clinical supervision. Supervision rates will vary based on the province and supervisor.

**Note 7:** As this course is cross-listed with a Doctoral level course, Masters level students are required to gain permission from the professor.
